Please follow the **SAMPLE GIFT LABEL** format via computer. You may submit them on standard 8 ½ x 11 white paper so that St. Francis can photocopy them onto label paper **or** by email and we will print them out to photocopy onto the label paper. Please use our <u>WORD file</u> or contact Susanna Brown if you have any questions. NOTE: *HAND-WRITTEN LABELS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNLESS THE HANDWRITING IS PRINTED CLEARLY AND NEATLY*.

<u>3.</u> **PICK-UP the GIFTS on Tuesday, Dec. 14 AND Monday, Dec. 20**, from St. Francis Parish Office. We are located in Ann Arbor on Stadium Blvd., between Washtenaw & Packard across the street from Tappan Middle School. Drive around the block to the back of the church to find our office at 2150 Frieze Avenue.

- 1) Only one gift idea per label! Please try to be personal and specific with your clients' needs.
- 2) If your gift idea is a gift certificate, DO NOT suggest a dollar amount.
- 3) We ask that gift ideas be focused more on your clients' "needs" and/or "reasonable wants" or the requests may be returned unfulfilled.
- 4) If your labels do not fit the above description, we may need to send them back to you to do over. We thank you, in advance, for your help.
- 5) Our volunteers enjoy gift-wrapping the presents. Please contact us if you have any concerns regarding gift-wrapping your presents.
